HAVE FUN TOGETHER

- **Play "Cowboy Says"** Play like, "Simon Says," but say, "Cowboy says," before each motion.
- Say any of the following motions: Say, "Howdy," pretend to lasso, wave hands up high, clap hands, stomp feet, give fist bumps, pretend to gallop, pet a horse, sweep the porch, etc.
- "I'm a Little Cowboy" Song Time Have kids repeat each line after you to the tune of "I'm a Little Teapot."
 - - *I'm a little cowboy,* (put on pretend hat)
 - - *Off I go!* (Pretend to gallop)
 - - I can gallop fast, (gallop quickly)
 - - And gallop slow! (Gallop slowly)
 - - When the sun is setting, (move hands down from sky)
 - - Off I roam (pretend to gallop)
 - - To the stable and then back home! (Gallop)

"God is (both hands point up)


always at work (pound fists on top of each other) for the good of everyone (two thumbs up) who loves Him." (hug self)




• Have kids say the verse after you several times in any of these fun ways: with eyes closed, in a whisper voice, in a loud voice, in western voice, etc.

Hey God! Thank You for loving us and caring about each of us! Please help us never forget that You have good plans for us. We love You! In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.






